UHP Community Liaisons (CLs) are residents who are hired onto project teams working to advance policies, programs and environmental changes that improve the health and quality of life of those most in need. The CL Framework is a tested model for citizen-centered engagement in government and community initiatives.

Community Liaisons advocate for policy, programmatic, & neighborhood changes:

- Improved streets, transportation, & parks
- Equitable access to health resources
- Services and support for older adults
- Access to healthy food

The Community Liaison Framework builds power in communities that have historically been left out of decision-making processes.
